1. For members of BGA Affiliated Gliding Clubs, a nominal fee is charged except where special exemptions are in place – see DGS Fee Schedule.
2. By signing this form, the applicant for Day Membership is making a declaration of medical fitness to fly in compliance with the provisions made in the BGA Laws & Rules/EASA and that the appropriate certification has been provided to the Day Member's Home Club.
3. Applicants for Day Membership should be prepared to provide evidence of medical fitness and flying experience (e.g. Pilot's Log Book) if requested to do so by the Duty Instructor.
4. By making this application the applicant is granting an indemnity to the Dartmoor Gliding Society against all claims of damages resulting from death, injury or loss or damage to personal effects as far as permitted under English Law.
5. In consideration of being admitted as a Day Member the applicant shall comply with the rules of the Dartmoor Gliding Society and the BGA.
6. Whilst the Dartmoor Gliding Society obtain limited insurance cover for Members, Temporary Members, Day Members and Visitors whilst using the Society's Facilities, all should satisfy themselves that the cover provided is adequate for their needs.
7. Applicants under the age of 18 years shall have this form countersigned by their parent or guardian.
